Uniform Updates

All **middle school students** will have the **OPTION** of wearing a **gray uniform polo shirt** with our Nativity Cross. Girls may also choose the navy polo and boys the royal blue polo uniform shirts. We piloted the gray shirt last year in our sixth grade and have worked with Donald's Uniform store to ensure that they will stock the gray polo for all middle school students this year. There will also be a limited number of gray polos for sale at the used uniform sale in July at Nativity.

Donald's has informed us that they, along with many other vendors, are experiencing some back-order delays with some of their merchandise. Please do not delay in purchasing your uniform items until the end of summer as they may likely not be available. Our students will be expected to be in full uniform on the first day of school so please plan accordingly.

A reminder that a proper fitting jumper or uniform skirt must be no shorter than two inches above the knee for our girls and young ladies. Many children grow over the summer so please make sure your daughter's uniform fits properly and meets these expectations.

General Appearance Guidelines

During the pandemic we relaxed the enforcement of our hair policies due to some families' concerns for going into a barbershop or hair salon related to COVID restrictions. **Next year we will be enforcing our slightly modified hair policy as listed below:**

Young Ladies

- Hairstyle and color should not distract or draw undue attention to the student.
- Hair should not be hanging in a student's eyes.
- No one is to dye her hair a color that cannot be grown naturally.

Young Men

- Hairstyle and color should not distract or draw undue attention to the student.
- Hair shall not touch the collar in back, nor extend below the eyebrows.
- No one is to dye his hair a color that cannot be grown naturally.
